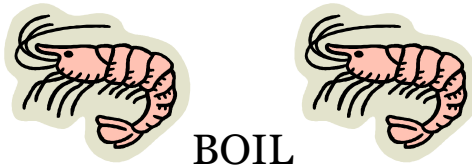
If you would be willing to give shag dance lessons for the last of September thru October please let Vickey VanFrank know.
